The final round of the Fishers Chamber Orchestra's Jongsun Lim Young Artist Competition was held on Saturday, January 10, 2009. Adjudicators Michael Vaughn, Phillip Palermo, and Dennis McCafferty selected cellists Brighton Yau, an eighth grader from Carmel, and Lydia Rhea, a third grader from Fishers, as co-winners of the junior division. Miss Rhea was also chosen as the recipient of the junior division award for "Best Performance by a Fishers Resident."

The senior division first place winner is violinist Rachel Mossburg from Uniondale, Indiana. She is currently a junior, and is a member of the New World Youth Orchestras. Her brother, Aaron Mossburg, was last year's senior division winner. In second place, the judges selected cellist WaWa Yin of Fishers. Miss Yin was also selected to receive the award for "Best Performance by a Fishers Resident" in the senior division.

Other finalists included violinist Joel Davenport of Fishers; cellist Benjamin Huang of Carmel; violinist Jacob Mossburg of Uniondale; violinist Ann Mozina of Carmel; violinist Sarah Page of Greenwood; and cellist Anna Pulliam of Indianapolis.

The first place winner of the senior division and co-winners of the junior division will perform their works with the Fishers Chamber Orchestra on Sunday, March 1 at the Promise Church in Fishers.
